Proposals by Sandy Dron

I feel that the competition rules need to be amended to reflect the restrictions on entries to the Silver Jubilee Trophy & Officers Cup.

The Jubilee Trophy is restricted to those over 60 plus to be played in the morning or afternoon.

The Officer's Cup is open to current & past officers of affiliated clubs & the Association. Finally at the semi-final stage of all competitions if both members / teams are from the same club then the requirement to play on a neutral green be waived.

After a discussion it was agreed to change the Jubilee Trophy by deleting the morning and afternoon playing restrictions times as some over 60,s would not be able to enter if still working, with that amendment All proposals were passed
